TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PAYMENT: Cash/Cheque/Credit Card/eTransfer

At least 50% is to be paid upon registration with the balance paid by cheque dated Nov.15 & attached to registration. Fees must be paid in full prior to tests, competitions and carnival.

A Family Discount is available for a family with 3 or more skaters. Discount determined at registration.

\$30 service fee charged on NSF cheques. Anyone with 2 NSF cheques must pay by cash only.

All past due accounts must be paid prior to new season registration. Partial fee payment is not an option for skaters with an overdue account.

CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY:

Refunds will only be given during first 3 weeks of your skating session. A \$90 fee will be withheld. Refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Club

SKATE CANADA PRIVACY POLICY

Skate Canada requires clubs to include the Notice of Collection Statement on their registration forms. Skate Sarnia uses the personal information collected on the registration form in order to:

- Contact skater/parent re: Club activities or events
- Arrange for appropriate costumes for the carnival

Register the skater with Skate Canada

- Personal information collected on the form includes: Skater Name, sex, birth date
- Parent/Guardian Name, address, phone number, email address

The Skate Canada Privacy Policy is intended to ensure your personal information is used only for its intended purpose, accessible only on a need-to-know basis, and not disclosed without authorization nor used for personal gain. All Skate Sarnia Board Members and Professional Coaches are required to sign and abide by the Skate Canada Privacy Policy as a condition of being on the Board or employed as a coach. CANSKATE PROGRAMS

CANSkate is a learn-to-skate program focussed on fun. participation & basic skill development needed to take part in any skating sport. It's offered in three ability-based programs. Skaters may progress to the next level during the season through regular on-session testing. Awards & incentives help encourage skaters. Professional Coaches aided by trained Program Assistants teach the programs.

One session/week: either day \$380 \$540 Two sessions/week: both days

PRECANSKATE - cancelled due to COVID-19

Geared towards beginners (age 3-5) with little or no experience, this program is focussed on fun & participation in age appropriate activities.

CANSKATE

Geared towards skaters (5 up) with minimal experience. Skaters are organized into ability appropriate groups to develop basic skating skills for CANSkate Stages 1 to 3.

ADVANCED CANSKATE

For experienced skaters above CANSkate Stage 3. Skaters progress from Stage 4 to 6 as they develop higher figure skating skills.

STAR 1 - GOLD SESSIONS

These sessions offer opportunities to develop stronger figure skating skills in ice dance, free skate & interpretive skate. Our professional coaches offer instruction in group &/or private lessons. Skaters have the opportunity to take nationally standardized Skate Canada tests.

Skaters must have CANSkate Stage 6 & a Professional Coach. Skaters should discuss with their coach what ice sessions they should register for, based on the skater's ability & objectives.

Level "A" sessions: STAR 3 - GOLD Level "B" sessions: STAR 1-3

STAR 1 – Gold registration fees do $\underline{\text{not}}$ include coaching fees. The registration fee is based on the number of STAR Ice sessions purchased.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

For skaters registered with another club who wish to register for Star 1 - Gold Ice. \$20

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ADULT SKATERS

Experienced adults may register for Star 1 - Gold sessions. A professional coach is not required.

GUEST SKATING

STAR 1 - Gold skaters wishing to skate on an extra session from time to time may request to "Guest Skate" This request is made through their coach to the Board. If granted permission, the "Guest Skate" is valid in one-hour increments and ONLY for the approved time. \$25/hr

CARNIVAL PRACTICE

The last two weeks of the season are exclusively reserved for carnival practice. Only skaters who registered for carnival are permitted on the ice.

POWER SKATING

Power Skating is designed to help hockey skaters develop better balance, power, agility, speed & endurance. Skaters are organized in ability appropriate groups and taught by our Power Skating Coach, aided by Program Assistants.

Power Skating is for skaters who already have basic skating skills. Skating skills, techniques & conditioning drills are taught in a way that emphasizes how the skills apply to game situations. Hockey gear is required. The program is offered on three sessions: one on Monday and two on Friday.

\$405 One session/week \$565 Two sessions/week

SKATE CANADA HELMET POLICY

All skaters, including adults, at CANSkate Stage 5 or below must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet while on the ice. In general, this applies to anyone who lacks good control/balance when skating forward, backward & has difficulty stopping & manoeuvring around on-ice obstacles.

PROMOTIONAL BOOKLET

This fundraiser supports our club & Skate Ontario. The cost is included in the registration fee. You sell the 20 \$2 tickets to family & friends & keep the \$40. Ticket stubs must be returned by January 31st. If you don't sell all the tickets, enter your own name on any unsold tickets before returning the stubs.

PROFESSIONAL COACHES

Several Professional Coaches are available to teach STAR 1 – Gold skaters on a private or semi-private basis. You choose a coach & the number of weekly lessons desired on the STAR sessions you select, in consultation with the coach. Coach's fees are in addition to Skate Sarnia fees. Our website provides contact information for our coaches.
